Dear Neighbors and fellow Missoulians:

In support of the [Rattlesnake neighborhoods](#), [Safe Routes to School Program](#), [Rattlesnake Creek Watershed Group](#) and [Missoula's Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Board mission](#), please provide your input on:

- 1) Proposal 1: Open Missoula Avenue to become a greenway with a diverging one-way traffic pattern.
- 2) Proposal 2: Connect [Greenough Park](#) and [Bugbee Nature Preserve](#) for bicycles and pedestrians for a Mountain View Drive to Spruce St route.

## **Proposal #1 - Car-Free Missoula Ave Highlights [map](#)**

---

- 1) Reduces vehicle-bicycle vehicle-pedestrian accidents.
- 2) Eliminates the blind northbound left turn from Rattlesnake Drive onto Missoula Ave thereby reducing head-on collisions.
- 3) Eliminates Missoula Ave redundancy.
- 4) Makes bike/ped traffic between Tom Green Memorial Park and Bugbee Nature Preserve safer.
- 5) South end of Missoula Ave accessible via one-way Richard St.
- 6) One-way Herbert St becomes Missoula Ave Rattlesnake Dr conduit.

## **Proposal #2 - Mountain View to Spruce Street Corridor Highlights [map](#)**

---

- 1) Eliminates the need for cyclists and pedestrians to use Rattlesnake Drive, Van Buren Street, Duncan Drive, or West Greenough Drive to get to [Downtown Missoula](#) from the Rattlesnake thereby reducing accidents and saving time.
- 2) Supports the mission of [Missoula In Motion](#) by reducing single-occupant motorized vehicle use and enhancing transportation options.
- 3) Gives cyclists and hikers a green corridor to access the [Rattlesnake National Recreation Area & Wilderness](#).
